

SATURN - VENUS & VENUS –SATURN PEIRODS – A PARADOX

Uttara kalamrita is an interesting astrological classic authored by One Kalidaasa (Not the renowned Sanskrit play writer) in the 17th century. He was from South India, probably from Tamilnadu.

In this work, the author makes some interesting observations regarding Saturn-Venus and Venus- Saturn periods, which will really baffle us but are accurate to a great extent. His observations are as below:

1. If Saturn and Venus are in their exaltation, own sign or vargottama or otherwise strong and powerful to give yoga and good results, then in their mutual major and minor periods, these periods will make even a king or kubera a beggar. The native becomes powerless. If one of these planets is strong and the other is weak, the yoga will come from the stronger planet in it's other sub periods.

In the birth chart of Sri N.Sanjeeva reddy, a former president of our country, Saturn is vargottama and Venus is yoga karaka. He became president of India in the major period of Venus. But when the sub period of Saturn started, he had to undergo life threatening heart surgery.

2. If Saturn and Venus are both weak and are even placed in 6,8 or 12 houses from each other, or if they own such houses, their mutual major- minor periods will prove very beneficial and give success, happiness and enjoyment. If one owns a benefic house and the other a malefic house, then also their mutual major-minor periods will give good results. Even if both of these planets are malefics, their mutual dasa-antardasaas will be highly favourable.

Dr. P.S. Sastry, who translated this work from Sanskrit into English found that the above dicta are working, albeit with slight modifications. I request the viewers to check their charts or their clients' charts and give their predictions keeping in view, these surprising paradoxical dicta.

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
